Ultimately the purpose of installing an extra set of split hooks in the center of the board helps with the play or movement that occurs when edging hard or riding over changing snow conditions. The two board halves tend to move vertically between each other, in the area between your bindings (the space between the white dimension lines below). Keep in mind both below installation positions are effective, one just prevents you from using the Voile crampons.

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Here you can see the yin-yang split hooks for the center of the board. The hooks are installed here if you plan to use the factory Voile crampons.

Here is the balance point of the board. This is usually not the center of the board.

Here is the center of the board as referenced between the inserts. This is where the split hooks would be installed if you are not going to use Voile crampons. The advantage of installing here is that it is slightly more centered on the board and the split hooks are hidden by your binding/touring bracket when in touring mode (visually more appealing).
